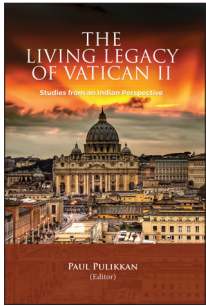

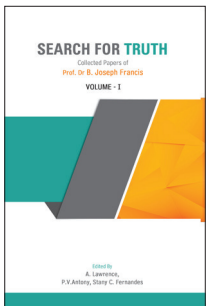

is that they set us thinking and help develop our own point of view for the Christian life.

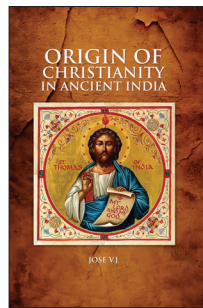
